European Pesticide Residue Workshop 2010

The European Pesticide Residue Workshop is the premier European meeting for the presentation and discussion of the latest concepts and developments in the field of pesticide residues in food and drink. Previous workshops have been held in The Netherlands (1996), Spain (1998), UK (2000), Italy (2002), Sweden (2004), Greece (2006) and Germany (2008).

The Scientific Committee of the EPRW comprises representatives of eight European countries. The workshop aims at the exchange of information and experience and brings together analytical chemists, quality managers, pesticide regulators, scientists from food control agencies, consumer groups, universities, private laboratories, the agrochemical and food industry, analytical equipment manufacturers and suppliers.
